Peter Alan Lundt, age 79, of Middleton, WI, passed away unexpectedly on Saturday, Sept. 21, 2019. Peter was an administrator for the International Laser Class Association in the 1970s.

He was born on June 13, 1940, in Elkhart, Ind., the son of Milo and Helen (Carpenter) Lundt. Peter graduated from Elkhart High School. He studied and lived abroad in France and St. Lucia which helped shape him into the man he was. Peter studied for his undergraduate at Haverford College, going on to UW-Madison for his doctoral studies.

He was a prolific sailor and competed globally, active in Lasers, scows, 470s, and DN iceboats. Peter was an administrator for the International Laser Class Association in the 1970s and involved with the Hooper Sail Club, the Mendota Yacht Club, the Four Lake Ice Yacht Club, and Lake Monona Sailing Club.

He enjoyed collecting fast cars and was a member of many car clubs. Peter was heavily involved in the Dane County Democratic politics.

Peter is survived by his son, Hans Lundt; daughter, Caroline Cumiskey; former wife and mother to his children, Barbara Segal; and many close friends. He was preceded in death by his parents; and former wife, Janice "Bunny" O'Connell.
